

■ KYUSHU OPEN 2020—How to play your round; Rules and OB

Round 1 and Round 2 are 27 hole rounds played as a group. A 40 minute lunch break is stagger scheduled according to group. Depending on your starting hole, your round will end on either hole 14 or hole 27. (precise schedule is listed on a separate document)

Pros play all rounds within their class divisions. Amateurs play mixed divisions for Round 1 and within their class for Round 2 on day 2.

General Out of Bounds Rules					boundary lines also indicate OB. In ponds (the line is where water meets land), covered rest areas, and toilets is OB.
Local Rules					If a disc lands in an impenetrable bush where taking a stance is unsafe or impossible, players may go back along the line of play, mark a lie, and throw.

1	148	4	95	4	In pond and in putt golf area is OB. Pros who miss mandatory take a penalty stroke and throw from the amateur tee.
2	182	4	132	4	Putt golf area marked by ropes on right, and paved walking path and area left of it on left are OB. Paved walking path beyond basket is also OB.
3	147	4	94	3	Road on left and walking path beyond basket are OB. Walking path in front of green is also OB.
4	72	3	72	3	Road on left side is OB; confirm that bicycles are not nearby before throwing.
5	73	3	73	3	If players miss double mandatory defined by two tree trunks, take penalty and throw from Amateur tee.
6	50	3	50	3	Confirm basket area is clear before throwing. Watch for stakes in the ground on fairway.
7	32	3	32	3	Watch your step when walking in forested areas.
8	50	3	50	3	Confirm basket area is clear before throwing. Watch for stakes in the ground on fairway.
9	85	3	85	3	Cycling road beyond basket is OB. Concrete semicircle to the right of target is also OB.
10	70	3	70	3	Cycling road to left is OB.
11	98	3	72	3	Walking paths in fairway are OB for pro players. Confirm pedestrians are clear of area before throwing.
12	132	4	76	3	Area in front and left marked by ropes is OB. ※Please do not enter flower beds to get OB discs!
13	74	3	74	3	All areas outside the area defined by walking paths are OB. Confirm pedestrians are clear of area before throwing.
14	70	3	70	3	Walking path on left and areas beyond are OB.

■ After finishing hole 14, please report to tournament central. Then, follow the group ahead of you as they start play on hole 15.

19	248	5	166	4	Rope on left marks OB. Roped area on short left is also OB. Use a spotter to confirm approach shots from blind hill are safe.

21	118	4	118	5	Road beyond basket is OB. The walking path leading to toilet is SAFE.

23	68	3	68	3	Area near rest area to left of basket, walking path in front of basket, and road behind target are all OB.
24	210	5	154	5	Road on left is OB. When group ahead is near far away basket, tee off when safe.
25	83	3	83	3	Waling path in front of and behind goal is OB. If disc is lodged in thick bushes behind basket, see local rule (above).
26	66	3	66	3	Any disc in the pond is OB and player moves to drop zone with a stroke penalty. Players can also elect to throw first shot from DZ (playing 3).
27	52	3	52	3	Pond and roadway to right are OB.

■ When finished with hole 27, report to tournament central. Later, follow the group ahead of you when they start hole 1.

•Please observe 30 second rule after addressing your lie, and 3 minute rule for lost discs. If you fall behind the group ahead of you, hurry between holes. Slower groups may have less than 40 minutes for lunch time.

•Please turn in scorecards immediately after round. Stay safe, keep a good pace, and enjoy your experience of the Kyushu Open 2020!
